

## PHTHALATE-FREE X-RAY DETECTABLE YARN (MICROPAKE®)

Micropake® is an X-ray detectable yarn used in the manufacture of x-ray detectable gauze swabs and sponges. It is melt spun from phthalate-free polypropylene with a high loading of barium sulphate (60%). The yarn consists of 40 filaments, wrapped with a fine polyester thread.
